

Potential Master Plan Objectives

- Provide a framework that allows the Airport to meet the long-term air transportation needs of the region in a safe, secure, and efficient manner and in compliance with all Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and Transportation Security Administration (TSA) requirements.
- Identify the airfield, passenger terminal, ground transportation system, and aviation support facilities that are necessary to accommodate future aviation demand and fulfill the needs of all Airport users and stakeholders.
- Develop a flexible, long-range plan for terminal area expansion and the enhancement of passenger amenities.
- Provide strategies for improving Airport accessibility and the level of service of ground transportation, curbside, and parking activities.
- Provide a financial plan that establishes a schedule of development priorities to adequately meet the needs of the future demand for aviation facilities and services at the Airport.
- Promote the Airport as a major contributor to regional economic activity.
- Identify strategies to best utilize the collective resources offered by the Airport and the Indiana Air National Guard (IANG).
- Support the development of compatible land uses in the Airport vicinity in a manner that is sensitive to surrounding environments.
- Actively solicit the input of the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and the public throughout the planning process.
