The Fort Wayne-Alten County Airport Authority will receive sealed bids **until 11:00 a.m. eastern time on the 10th day of August, 2010** at the offices of the Airport Authority, Suite 209, 3801 W. Ferguson Road, Fort Wayne, Indiana, 46809 for the following:

A nonrefundable purchase price of eighty-five dollars (\$85.00) payable to Fort Wayne-Alten County Airport Authority, must be received before documents will be released.

Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 11:15 a.m. eastern time on the last date for receiving bids in the office shown above. Bids shall be properly executed and addressed to the office and address shown above, together with the documents required by the bid forms, specifications and related legal documents. A bid bond with good and sufficient surety, issued by a company licensed to do business in the State of Indiana, or, in the alternative, a certified check on a solvent bank, equal to ten percent (10%) of the total bid insuring that if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into and the performance of its proposal secured, must accompany the Contractor's bid.

It is the policy of the Authority to ensure that DBEs, as defined in Part 26, have an equal opportunity to receive and participate in DOT-assisted contracts. It is also our policy:

1. To ensure nondiscrimination in the award and administration of DOT assisted contracts;
2. To create a level playing field on which DBEs can compete fairly for DOT assisted contracts;
3. To ensure that the DBE Program is narrowly tailored in accordance with applicable law;
4. To ensure that only firms that fully meet 49 CFR Part 26 eligibility standards are permitted to participate as DBEs;
5. To help remove barriers to the participation of DBEs in DOT assisted contracts; and
6. To assist the development of firms that can compete successfully in the market place outside the DBE Program.

An eight percent (8%) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise participation goal has been set for this project.

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
A Whole New Altitude
